



Stay in School


Low socioeconomic status (SES) students with a high participation in the arts have a dropout rate of 4 percent, but their peers with a low participation in the arts have a dropout rate of 22 percent.

- 2. Art builds a keener sense of perception, contributing to making better decisions.
- 3. Art engages the senses.
- 4. Art helps you relax.
- 5. Art stimulates creativity.
- 6. Art helps develop individuality and independence.
- 7. Art helps to build self-esteem.
- 8. Art gives you a sense of well-being.
- 9. Art generates enjoyment. Its social!
- 10. Art promotes self-expression.
- 11. Art promotes abstract thinking.
- 12. Art gives you a feeling of accomplishment.
- 13. Art promotes non-verbal communication skills.
- 14. Art is exhilarating.
- 15. Art teaches us more about ourselves than we imagined.

- There are so many creative job fields a student can go into today! Choose a creative career path!




